## Reports to Head of School

- Leads instruction within the classroom to teach core technology competencies and model the integration of technology in all curricular areas.

- Co-teaches in classrooms to model the integration of technology in all curricular areas.
- Proactively researches technology (hardware and software) that would benefit the educational process, make recommendations, build and implement training program, and assist in implementation.
- Develops resources for faculty, aligning technology resources with grade-level and subject matter curriculum and technology standards.
- Provides training via hands-on workshops, videos, and documentation
- Works with the department heads to ensure the use of technology is curriculum driven, ageappropriate and consistent with best practices.
- Acts as a liaison between the Technology Department and the faculty
- Provides basic hardware and software support
- Supports the needs of the Technology Department as requested
- Research, organize, and set up technology systems, wired and mobile networks, computer labs, and computer systems
- Check, maintain, and secure new hardware and materials
- Assist in the keeping of the budget for technological improvements and additions
